Did You Know?

- Children in poverty are on average three grade levels behind their more affluent peers by the fourth grade.
- Two out of three of these children will end up on welfare or in prison.
- But **THERE IS HOPE!** Children in poverty who are reading proficiently by the end of 3rd grade have an 89% graduation rate.

You Can Make A Difference!

- ARISE2Read is a faith-based non-profit organization that brings schools and churches together to help children read proficiently.
- We use a simple sight word method to tutor children in reading and share the Gospel through after-school Good News Clubs.
- ARISE2Read provides a one-hour training for volunteers and ongoing support for leadership. Each volunteer must go through their local school board's background check approval process.
- Volunteers give one hour per week to coach two children for 30 minutes each.
- ARISE2Read is effective and inexpensive to implement and maintain.
